

## **Uta Peyrer Expanding Space and Stretching Time**

In collaboration with the Austrian Cultural Forum, the Czech Museum of Fine Arts, Prague, is staging an exhibition by two major Austrian artists, the painter **Uta Peyrer** and the sculptor **Karl Prantl**.

The paintings of Austrian artist Uta Peyrer are being presented for the first time in the Czech Republic. In its ground-floor and first-floor spaces, the Czech Museum of Fine Arts is acquainting the public with a selection of Peyrer's work from the 1960s up to the present day. Her highly cultivated work is based on several series that have one particular feature in common: profoundly focused painting inspired by the relationship between the individual and the cosmos. Her work shares an affinity with that of several Czech artists who were similarly inspired from the 1960s onwards.
